The 2015 Operating Revenues are \$1,316,517 compared to \$1,291,786 in 2014 an increase of \$24,731. The increase in expenditures is caused by the net effect a provision for increase in additional administrative expenses LOSAP increase based on Advisor estimate increase and in members.

Amount to be raised by taxation in 2015 is \$1,094,897 compared to 2014 of \$1,070,166. The tax rate in 2015 is .0448 (4.48¢) per \$100 assessed valuation vs. .0440 (4.40¢) per \$100 assessed valuation in 2014. Unrestricted surplus utilized in 2015 of \$221,620 is the same as in 2014.

The Fire District's 2015 amount to be raised by taxation is in compliance with existing Property Tax Levy Cap.

An Average residential unit with an assessed valuation of \$383,000 will pay a fire tax of \$171.59 in 2015 compared to \$168.52 in 2014, an increase of \$3.07.
